**BIKEABILITY** Children in Years 5 and 6 completed their bikeability training last week. They learned a huge amount and thoroughly enjoyed the training.

**CURRICULUM TIME** Apart from transition morning on Tuesday 11th July the children will be continuing with their usual curriculum. 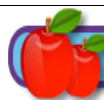
