This term should be another busy one with many more exciting opportunities and experiences planned for our children.

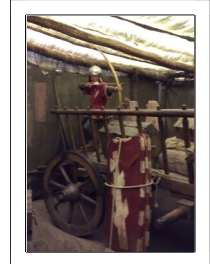
WORLD BOOK DAY
