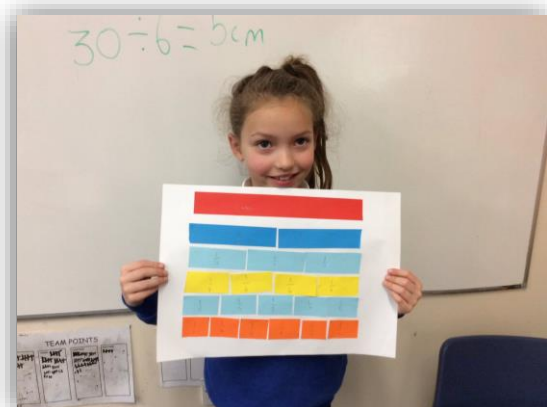

EARLY ACCESS CLUB



Thank you to all who responded to our survey before Christmas which related to the possibility of setting up an 'Early Access Club' each morning at school.

Whilst the number of families who thought that they would use the facility was not high, Governors have agreed to trial the scheme for the Summer Term to see if it is financially viable (i.e. covers the cost of staffing it).

Details will follow next week of how you can book in for 'Early Access' to the school at 8am for a cost of £1.50 per day initially. Please note that this is not a 'Breakfast Club' and although children will be supervised, they should bring with them a suitable book/puzzle book/ homework activity etc to keep them entertained for the half an hour before going to their first class.

This is one example of how we have listened to the needs of parents and hope that it fits the gap we currently have in terms of wrap around care.
