AFTER-SCHOOL CHILD-CARE AT WOODFORD

To enable us to schedule in available minibuses, please can I ask that you pre-book your child onto the minibus for transportation for the period from Tuesday 31st October - Tuesday 19th December 2017. Please could you submit your bookings in the school letter-box by Friday of next week - Friday 20th October, 2017.

When booking, please bear the following dates in mind and vary your requirements accordingly.

Just a reminder of the terms and conditions for transporting:

- You must make the necessary booking and payment direct with Woodford School;
- You must book transport with Great Addington using the form attached, in advance for the whole half term (up until 19th December, 2017) in order that we can schedule the minibuses. Extra days may be accommodated during the half term, provided that the bus has already been scheduled to run from advance bookings made. Please check with Christine before booking at Woodford. EXTRA DAYS must be made verbally to Christine in order that an immediate decision can be communicated;
- We cannot charge for transport, but voluntary donations are very much appreciated;
- Transport can only be made at the end of the school day (3 pm); we cannot transport children after Great Addington school clubs have finished;
- Children must be collected by you from Woodford School;
- Transport Forms to be returned to Great Addington for advance bookings by Friday 20th October, 2017, in order for us to schedule the buses;

We do hope that the children continue to enjoy the after school facility and that parents find it a great help with balancing work and child care.

YEAR 4 : FAITH ROADSHOW

Our year 4 children have been invited to attend a Faith Roadshow at Wicksteed Park on Wednesday 18th October with other schools from within the PDET Trust.

The roadshow, which is run by the St Philip's Centre, a charity which works to build good inter-faith relations through a programme of activities and courses, will give children the opportunity to learn about different world religions and beliefs all under one roof.

Children will engage in a series of fun and interactive exercises designed to help them learn about Baha'I, Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism, Humanism, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism. The roadshow will include food sampling and tents where children could try on items of clothing associated with different faiths and cultures. There will also be stalls where the children can handle and observe artefacts on display.
