### **January 2018 Online Safety Tip**

A recent survey by Barnardo's, the children's charity, found that only 55% of parents will monitor who their children speak to online. More than half the devices bought for children for Christmas were for children aged 10 and under. Javed Khan Barnardo's chief executive said "We understand how vital the online world is to children, but also how the risks can damage their childhood. Internet-connected devices like tablets can come in the guise of harmless dolls or teddy bears and potentially allow others to pinpoint your address, obtain your child's name and birthday, download their photo and even listen in on conversations." They advise parents to ensure their children are as safe as possible by ensuring privacy settings are at maximum and monitor who your children are communicating with.
