This term the children have been thinking about 'wisdom' and particularly:

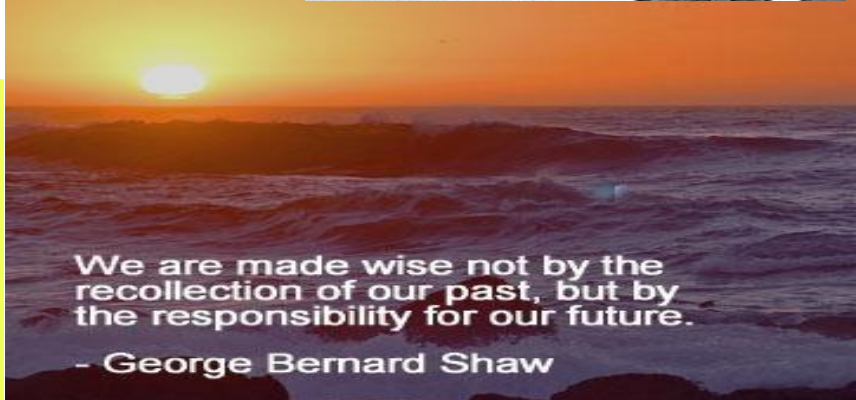
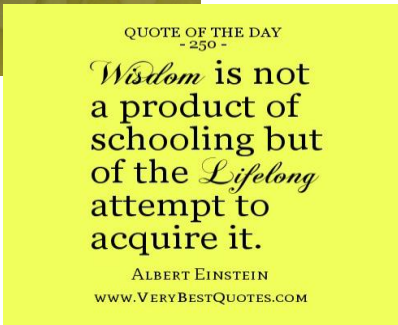
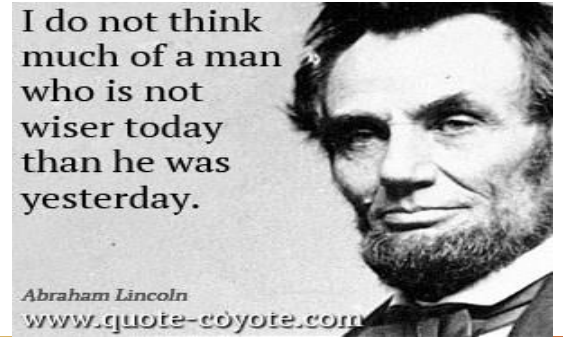
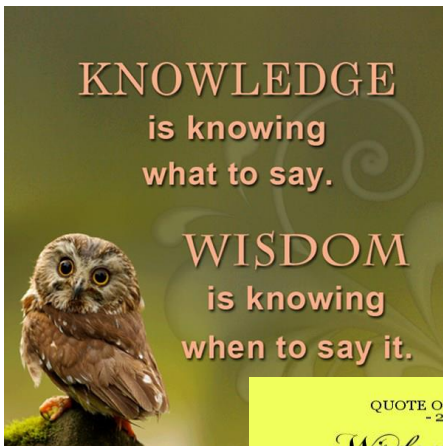
- How wisdom differs from knowledge;
