



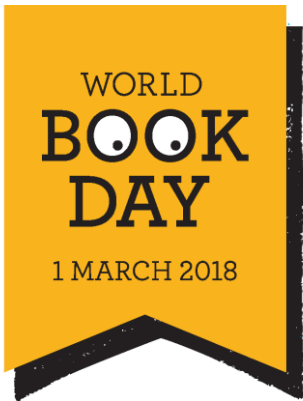

### World Book Day

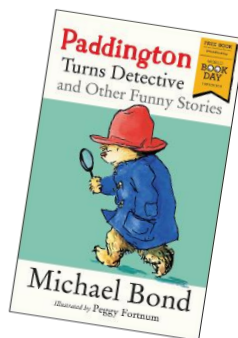
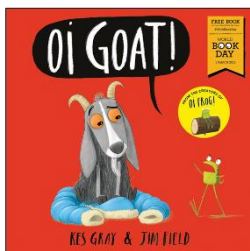
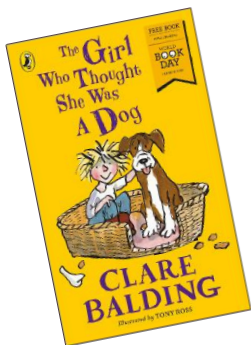
World Book Day is on **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March.**

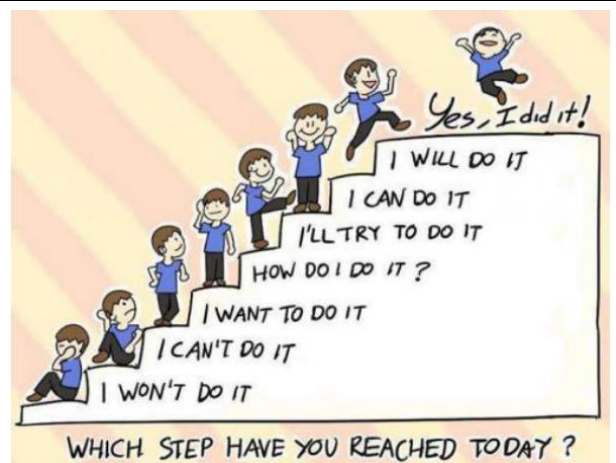
## Usborne Books and Scholastic Book Club
